The results of the September 30 parliamentary elections in Ukraine gave the Orange forces a narrow majority over the ruling Party of Regions and its allies. With coalition negotiations ongoing, questions of Ukraine’s future foreign policy direction emerge. Will a potential “Orange” government more clearly pursue integration with Euro-Atlantic institutions? How will the Party of Regions shape foreign policy from its likely new role as leader of the opposition? And how will an “Orange” government conduct relations with Russia, particularly on the issue of energy independence? Three of Ukraine’s top foreign policy experts - including two former foreign ministers - will address these issues and assess the outcome of the elections.
